# Re: - Bushfire Attack Level (BAL) Advice – Gainsborough Greens, Stage 3.1

Further to your request that we undertake an assessment and provide a determination of the Bushfire Attack Level (BAL) to which a number of Lots within the Gainsborough Greens Stages 3.1 would be exposed to please find our methodology and determination below.

## Assessment methodology

- 1. Review of Cold Coast Planning Scheme Bushfire Hazard Overlay Map covering the area (see Figure 1)
- 2. Review of the State Planning Policy, Natural Hazards, Risk and Resilience Bushfire Hazard mapping over the area (see Figure 2),
- 3. Review the latest Nearmap aerial images (26 May 2021) over the development area and adjacent areas (see Figure 3).

#### Findings

- 1. The Gold Coast Planning Scheme does not map any areas of hazardous vegetation within 100 metres of the development footprint for Stage 3.1,
- 2. The State Planning Policy, Natural Hazards, Risk and Resilience Bushfire Hazard mapping does not map any areas of bushfire hazard within 100 metres of the development footprint,
- 3. The review of the latest aerial photography, clearly indicates that the historic use of the adjacent areas of a gold course is still present and as such any vegetated area within 100 metres of the development footprint is either:
  - a. A single lines of trees along the edge of the fairways, where the understorey is regularly mowed for the benefit of the golfers,

b. A patch of vegetation with an understorey, however that patch is surrounded by either developed land or land which includes fairways, greens and sand traps and as such theses patches can be considered to be areas of low bushfire hazard due to their lack of size and lack of connectivity to any areas of significant bushfire hazard.

### Conclusion

Based on our assessment of the potential bushfire risks associated with the Stage 3.1 of the Gainsborough Greens we conclude that no lot within Stage 3.1 of the Gainsborough Greens development: -

- 1. Is located greater than 100 metres from any area of mapped and verified bushfire hazard in both the Gold Coast Planning Scheme Bushfire Hazard Overlay Map and the State Planning Policy, Bushfire hazard map;
- 2. Therefore, no Class 1, 2 and/or 3 or Class 10A structure that could be constructed upon any lot within Stage 3.1 are required to respond to AS3959-2018 as a deemed to comply with the National Construction Code (NCC) 2019. This includes the following lots:


